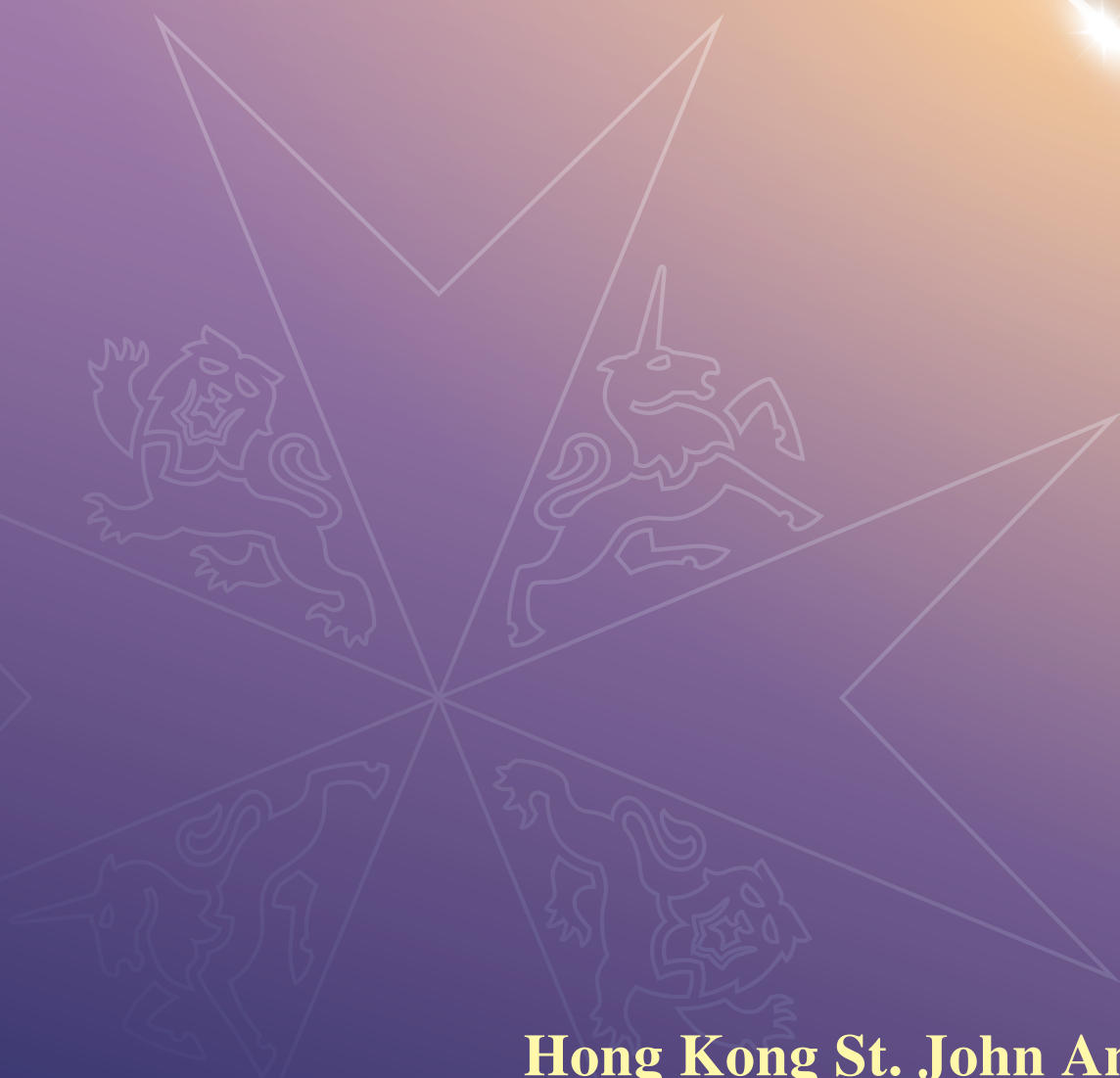

INTRODUCTION

Introduction

The **Hong Kong St. John Ambulance Association** has been established in Hong Kong for 134 years. It was first started in 1884 and inaugurated in 1900. The **Brigade**, the service arm of the Organization, was formally established in 1916 during World War I, followed by the establishment of the **Council** in 1949. Ever since then, St. John in Hong Kong has been active in the provision of First Aid training and allied services to the public.

The principle and spirit of Hong Kong St. John Ambulance as embodied in the motto “**For the Service of Mankind**” remain unchanged after the enactment of the new **Hong Kong St. John Ambulance Incorporation Ordinance (Chapter 1164)** on 27 June 1997. Hong Kong St. John Ambulance continues in promoting and encouraging all works of humanity and charity for the relief of distress, suffering, sickness and danger without any distinction as to race, class or creed.

The **Council** is the supreme governing body of **Hong Kong St. John Ambulance** and is charged with the governance, management and control of all business and activities of the Corporation. The Council is composed of dedicated volunteers from various professions and the Assistant Director (Administration and Policy) of Department of Health also sits in the Council as Observer. The Council’s work is facilitated by its standing Committees, namely, Two MacDonnell Road Management, Finance, Honours and Awards, Public Relations, Property Management and Development, Greater China Affairs and Ambulance Service Steering.

The **Association**, the training branch, has been the premier organization of the territory responsible for instructing members of the general public the principles and practice of First Aid, Home Nursing and allied subjects since 1884. The **Director’s Conference** ensures that training works of the Association are conducted effectively and efficiently. There are 530 volunteer lecturers or instructors, including doctors, nurses and allied health professionals.

The **Brigade**, the service branch, is responsible for organizing training and equipping adult and youth members to undertake, on a voluntary basis, First Aid, Home Nursing and Ambulance Services to those in need. The service is free. The **Commissioner’s Conference** is responsible for overseeing the organization, administration, services provision and development of the Brigade. At present, there are 7,662 members, made up of 3,130 Adult and 4,532 Youth members including 252 members from St. John Pandas.

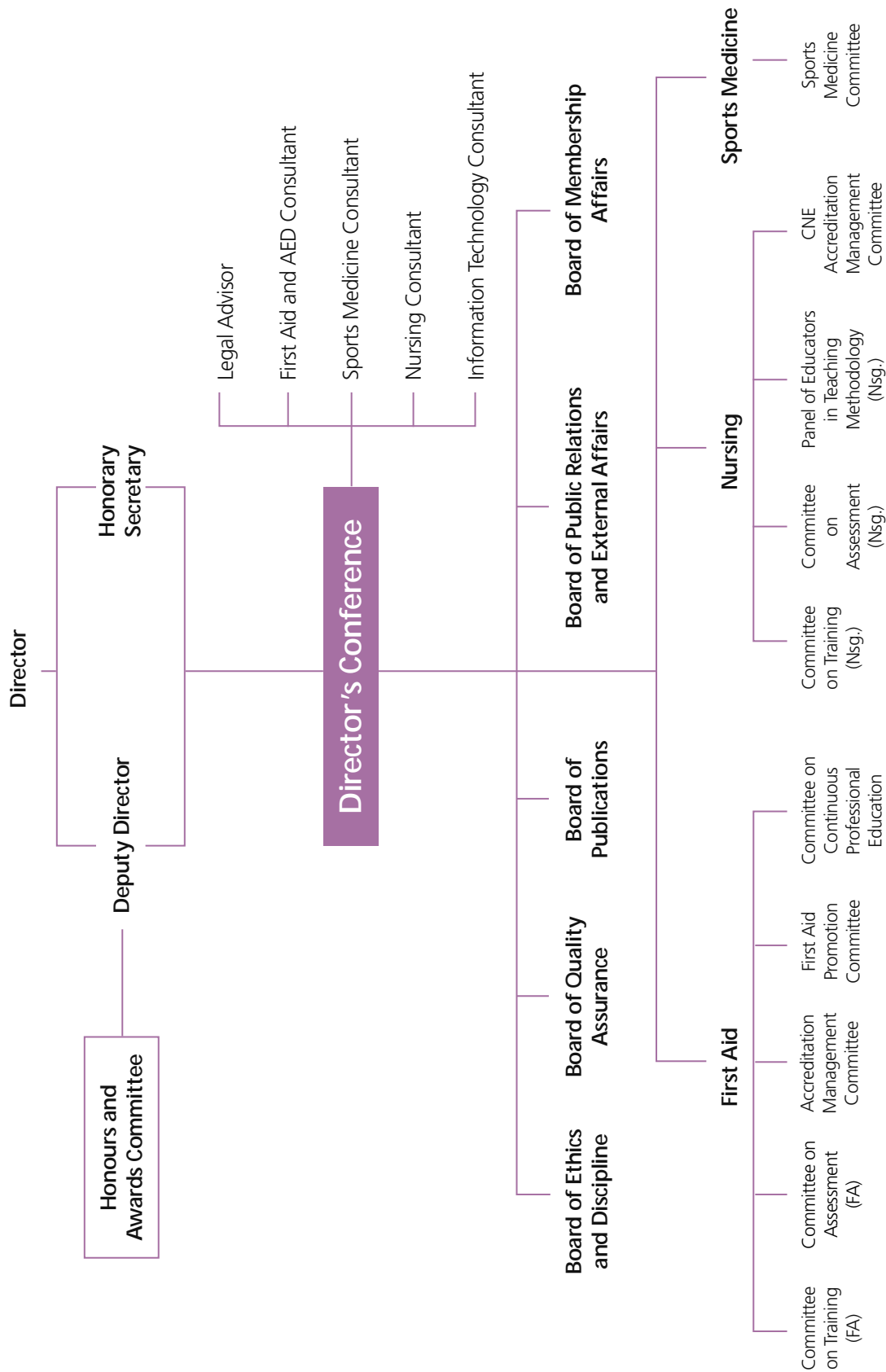

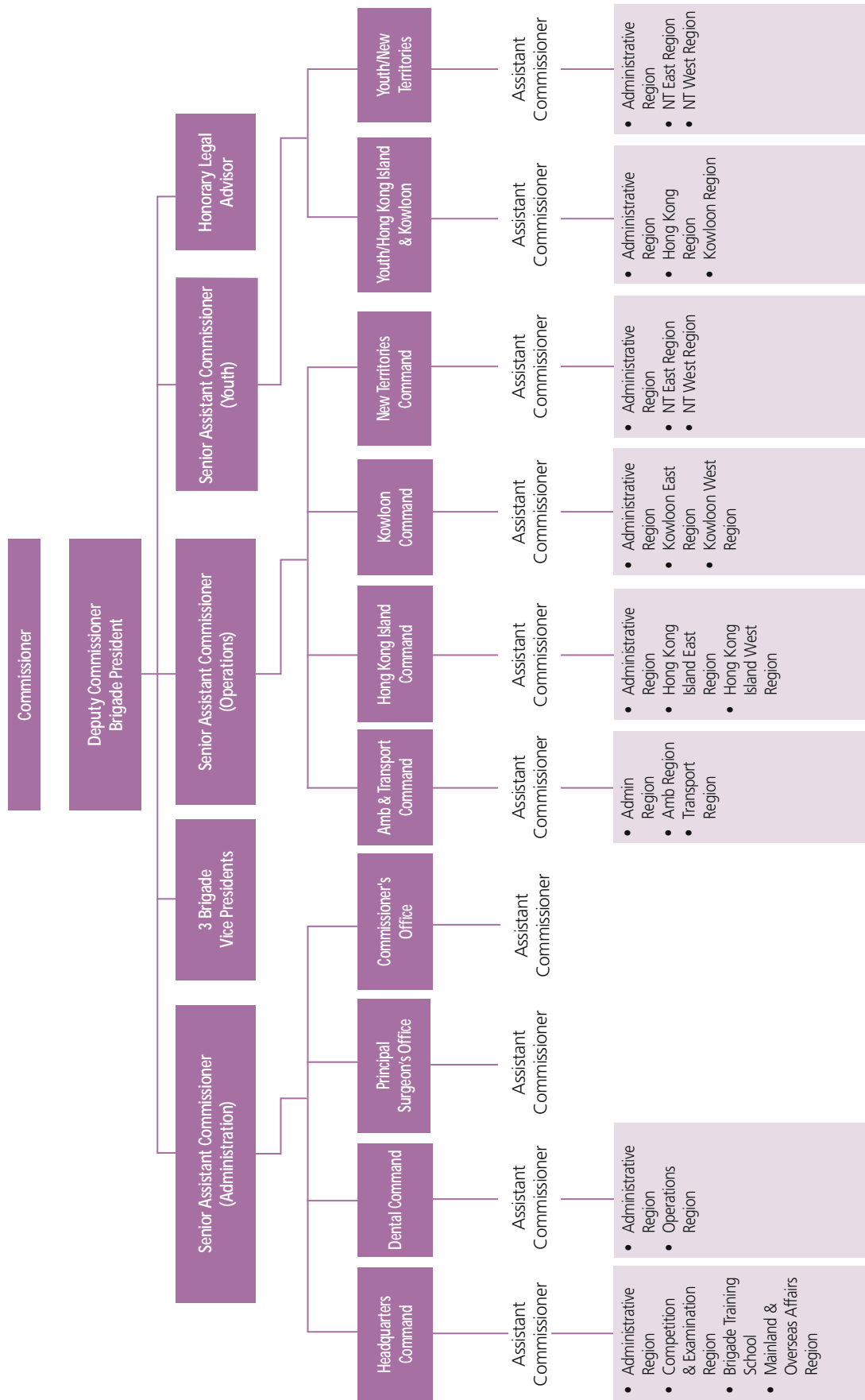

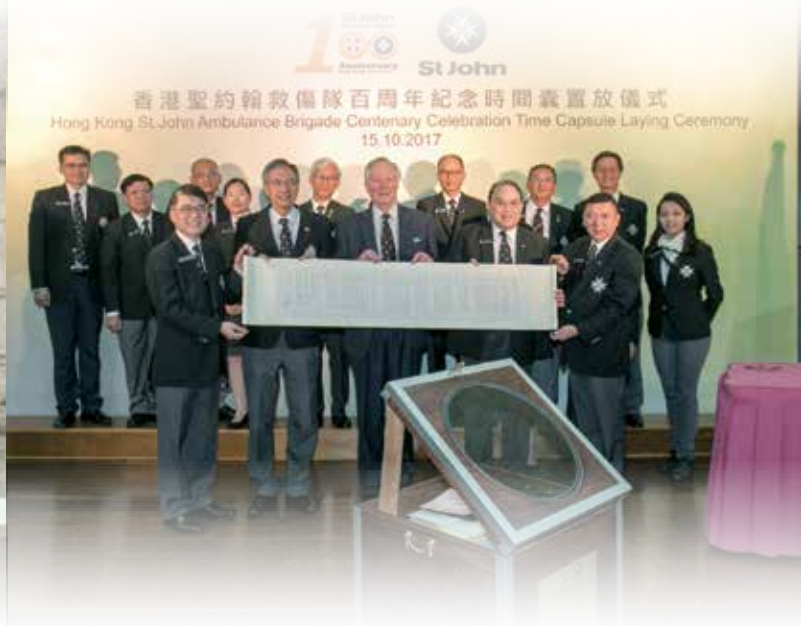


HIGHLIGHTS OF THE YEAR

- 2 The Sports Medicine Committee had reviewed the curriculum of First Aid Specialty Course on Sports Emergencies and published a **Sports Manual** in June 2017 for the public and other interested parties, especially those working in sports and recreation areas. Credits would be given to the volunteer doctors, lecturers and instructors for their professional advices and assistance.

To facilitate the Instructors in course delivery, the Committee conducted a workshop introducing the content of the manual and updating information on sports emergencies in November 2017.



3 The **Brigade Centenary Celebration (BCC) London and Cardiff Visiting Tour** was held from 20-29 June 2017. A total of 109 persons including Officers, Presidents, Adult and Cadet Members participated in this memorable event, which marked the summit of the whole BCC celebrations. Visits included The Priory of England and The Islands, the St. John's Gate and Priory Church. The Delegation had the privilege of attending the Annual St. John's Day Commemorative Service in St. Paul's Cathedral. They also had the opportunity of meeting the new Prior of Wales in Cardiff and enjoyed a warm welcome from The Priory of Wales.



4 The **Annual Parade of Brigade** was held on Sunday, 12 November 2017 at Hong Kong Police College, Wong Chuk Hang. Dr. Chung Chin-hung, Prior of The St. John Priory of Hong Kong officiated at the ceremony.



- 5 The year of 2017 marked the 20th Anniversary of the Establishment of the HKSAR. To celebrate this memorable moment and to advocate civic education among St. John Pandas, **Panda Orienteering Competition** was organized on Sunday, 17 December 2017 at the Jockey Club Tai Tong Holiday Camp. A total of 200 Panda Members and their family members attended the event with the aims to nurture their civic awareness, deepen the understanding of Hong Kong and enhance the connection with St. John through the competition.



- 6 **The Secretary for Home Affairs' (SHA) Commendation Scheme** aims at offering recognition to special achievements of individual volunteer leaders of each Uniformed Group under the purview of SHA in youth development works.

Superintendent Lau Wai-kit and Superintendent Au William of Youth Command were awarded the Volunteer Leader Commendation. While Senior Ambulance Officer Ng Chi-fai and Ambulance Officer Tsang Yuen-sheung were awarded the Youth Volunteer Leader Commendation in recognition of their outstanding and continuous contribution in youth works through the Hong Kong St. John Ambulance Brigade Youth Command. The Presentation Ceremony was held on Thursday, 28 December 2017 at the Central Government Office.



- 7** The **Spring Reception of Hong Kong St. John Ambulance Brigade** was held on Monday, 26 February 2018 at Aw Boon Haw Hall, St. John Tower. Over 250 guests including Senior Officials from Government Bureaux and Departments, Representatives from the Liaison Office of the Central People's Government, Heads of Uniformed Groups and schools attended the reception.



- 8** St. John always maintains close and good contacts with the media to publicize our service and work to the public. A **Press Lunch** was held on Monday, 19 March 2018 at Café Bar on 8, 8/F, 2 MacDonnell Road, Hong Kong to give the media a better understanding of the new initiatives of St. John in the coming year. The feedbacks from the media were overwhelming with reports in newspapers, Radio Television Hong Kong (RTHK), Television Broadcasts (TVB) etc.



- 9 The **Hong Kong St. John Ambulance Annual Dinner** was held on Saturday, 3 March 2018 at the Kowloonbay International Trade & Exhibition Centre. Under the competent chairmanship of Mr. Alfred Poon Sun-biu, Brigade Commissioner and Dr. Donald Li Kwok-tung, Association Director, the feedback was overwhelming. In total, 168 tables were occupied and over 2,000 members of St. John attended.



- 10 A **Courtesy Visit to the Department of Health** led by Dr. Chung Chin-hung, Council Chairman, was held on Tuesday, 27 March 2018, meeting with the representatives of the Department of Health led by Dr. Constance Chan Hon-ye, JP, Director of Health. The new services and plans were introduced by St. John during the meeting.



Service Reports

- 1 During the reporting year, the Brigade discharged a total of 324,294 man-hours of volunteer first aid, ambulance duties, dental and community services for the public.
- 2 In 2017/2018, the Brigade responded to 8,421 emergency and non-emergency calls for ambulance services. A detailed breakdown of these calls is tabulated below for easy reference.

3 Dental Service

The Dental service provided by Hong Kong St John Ambulance Brigade has been in operation for over 67 years. This is the only dental service provided among the global St. John Ambulance organizations.

Free dental service is made available to the elderly and patients with special needs by Brigade volunteer dental surgeons, dental surgery assistants and members at the Dental Clinic located at the St. John Headquarters or to the elderly homes by the Outreach Team. In addition, oral health services are provided to the public through campaigns and special events.

In 2017/2018, volunteers in the Dental Command provided dental services to a total of 1,343 patients, out of whom 2,737 cases were treated in the dental clinic. In addition, 6,445 members of the general public received free consultations and oral examinations through various health promotional projects and a total of 5,719 patients, the majority of whom were having various degrees of intellectual disability, received free basic dental treatment, including oral examination, dental prophylaxis, fillings and extractions.

“Special Smile” Project 2015-2017 (微笑行動)

The Community Chest of Hong Kong sponsored over HK\$3 million for provision of free dental service to children and young persons under 21-year old who live in Small Group Homes, Boy’s and Girl’s Home or Children’s Home and pre-school children aged 2 to 6 who receive care and/or education in the Special Needs Education (SNE) Centres or Kindergartens. From 1 April 2017 to 31 March 2018, there were 1,465 patients with 1,526 cases being treated under the project. The feedbacks proved this very meaningful for those underprivileged groups.



Trainings

For the Public/Organizations

1 Advanced Medical Life Support (AMLS) Course

In 2016, the Association became the Hong Kong sole provider of the Advanced Medical Life Support (AMLS) course which was developed by the National Association of Emergency Medical Technicians (NAEMT) of the United States and introduced through the China-Hong Kong Chapter of the American College of Surgeons. Apart from the theoretical aspects, interactive simulations and problem solving scenarios have given participants realistic exposure to cases. Course participants were mainly doctors and nurses. In 2017, the AMLS courses were conducted between April and September with 54 participants attended.



2 Advanced Life Support in Obstetrics (ALSO)

ALSO provider courses have been jointly organized by the Hong Kong College of Emergency Medicine and the Hong Kong College of Obstetricians & Gynaecologists for seven consecutive years at St. John Tower. Three ALSO provider courses were conducted on 11-12 May, 15-16 May, 17-18 May 2017 and an Instructor course on 13 May 2017 at St. John Tower with 122 nurses and doctors participated.



3 Free Cardio-Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and Automated External Defibrillation (AED) Training Courses for Members of the Public

The Sir Robert Ho Tung Charitable Fund has granted the Association funding for the 8th consecutive year for conducting free 6-hour CPR & AED training for members of the public. The project was conducted from May 2017 to August 2017 with 1,972 participants attended.



4 MTR First Aid Competition 2017

Since 2012, MTR has invited the Association to organize First Aid Competitions to enhance the level of competence of MTR staffs in emergency situations. In 2017, the competition was conducted on 16 May 2017 at Fo Tan MTR Depot. An Emergency Physician, Dr. Lau Hung-lam and an Assistant Training Manager led a team of eight to act as judges in the competition. Twenty-four teams, each with 3 members, participated in the competition by applying first aid skills in designated scenarios and timeframe.



5 Basic Life Support in Obstetrics (BLSO™) Provider Course

The American Academy of Family Physicians has granted the Association a license to conduct Basic Life Support in Obstetrics (BLSO™) Provider Courses in Hong Kong. The course objective is to provide training to pre-hospital care providers who wish to increase their knowledge and skills in obstetric emergencies. Courses were held between June and December 2017. Candidates who passed the assessment were awarded a certificate valid for 5 years.



6 Sports Expo 2017

The 6th Sports Expo was held at the Kowloonbay International Trade and Exhibition Centre from 11-13 August 2017. The Association was invited by the Resuscitation Council of Hong Kong to demonstrate how to use an Automated External Defibrillator (AED) and introduce cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and AED skills on 13 August 2017.



7 Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) Education Project of Rotary

With the sponsorship of Rotary International District 3450, the first series of courses for the members of public was conducted in 2016. In 2017, the targeted beneficiaries were students and staff of schools. The Opening Ceremony of the second phase was held on Saturday, 21 October 2017 at St. John Tower. Dr. Chui Tak-yi, JP, Under Secretary for Food and Health was invited as Officiating Guest of the ceremony. Brigade members were invited to attend the event and shared their experience of a case of successfully saving the life of a sudden cardiac arrest patient by applying an AED machine. Twelve Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and Automated External Defibrillation (AED) courses were conducted from 9 November 2017 to 9 March 2018 and 405 participants were trained.



8 Pre-hospital Trauma Life Support (PHTLS) Courses

The Association has become the sole provider of PHTLS courses in Hong Kong since 2002. The course was developed by the National Association of Emergency Medical Technicians (NAEMT) of the United States and was introduced into Hong Kong by the China-Hong Kong Chapter of the American College of Surgeons. This two-day intensive course gives instructions on kinematics of injuries, assessment and management of trauma patients with multiple injuries. Prospective trainees include doctors, nurses and pre-hospital care providers.

Training for and in the Guangdong Province Traditional Chinese Medicine Hospital was held in September 2017. A total of 8 doctors and nurses were trained. The course was delivered by PHTLS instructors from the Mainland, Taiwan and Hong Kong.



9 Wong Tai Sin District Healthy & Safe City

The Association was invited by Wong Tai Sin District Healthy & Safe City and District Fire Safety Committee (Wong Tai Sin District) to attend the 「齊心防火・救心嘉年華 2017」 Carnival on Saturday, 9 December 2017. St. John Lecturers (First Aid) demonstrated CPR and AED to members of the general public. The Director of the St. John Ambulance Association, Dr. Donald Li Kwok-tung was invited to present certificates to the participants.



10 1-hour First Aid Talk for Primary and Secondary Schools

With the aim of promoting First Aid at schools, the Association has been providing 1-hour First Aid Talk to secondary students since September 2012. To further promote first aid knowledge and skills to children, the 1-hour First Aid Talk has been extended from secondary schools to primary schools since September 2014. In the academic year 2016-17, the total number of students taught was 32,184 with 16,025 primary students and 16,159 secondary students in 177 schools (87 primary and 90 secondary schools).



- 11 Emergency Medicine Unit, The University of Hong Kong organized a **Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) Marathon 2018** that aimed to set a new world record from 3 February 2018 to 5 February 2018 at the Fire and Ambulance Services Academy, Tseung Kwan O. Hong Kong St. John Ambulance was invited as one of the supporting organizations to participate in this meaningful event.



For Lecturers/Officers and Members

1 Self-active Pain Management Programme

Nowadays, many people suffer from chronic pain which may decrease their quality of life. A self-active pain management programme was organized between September and December 2017 for Lecturers/Instructors as a Continuous Professional Education Programme. The aim of this programme was to introduce concepts of the causes of pain and the related risk factors. Also, active release techniques, stretching exercises, motor control skills and core stability exercise were introduced and practiced by participants of the programme.



For Mainland

- 1 Attendance at the 20th Annual Congress of the Chinese Society of Emergency Medicine (中華醫學會急診醫學分會 - 第二十次全國急診醫學學術年會) from 22-24 June 2017 in Jinan, Shandong.
- 2 A Training Course with Qingdao Emergency Centre (青島市急救中心) was held from 5-6 September 2017 in Qingdao.
- 3 Participation in the 6th First Aid Skills Competition (第六屆全國急救中心急救技能大賽) from 3-5 December 2017 in Haikou.
- 4 A Training Course with Beijing Chaoyang Emergency Medical Rescuing Centre (北京市朝陽區緊急醫療救援中心) was held from 13-16 March 2017 in Beijing.

- 2** **Hong Kong Uniformed Groups 10,000 miles Friendship Trek** is a cultural exchange program jointly organized by Hong Kong Uniformed Youth Groups and Liaison Office of the Central People's Government, HKSAR. With an aim to foster "people-to-people bond" as well as to promote communication and cultural exchange between the youth and the counterparts in the Belt and Road countries, Youth Command organized the Exchange Program with Almaty and Astana, Kazakhstan from 11-18 August 2017. Six Officers and twenty Cadet Members from Youth Command joined the 8-day Exchange Program to enhance our Cadet Members to have a better understanding on their academic studies, career and personal development as well as the future development of Hong Kong which are all closely related to our country's Belt and Road Initiatives.

Council Chairman, Brigade Senior Management, guests and around 180 St. John personnel attended the Service.



- 9** In order to develop the St. John team spirit and promote physical fitness among Cadet Members, **Cadets' Sports Day 2017** was held on Tuesday, 26 December 2017 at North District Sports Ground. A total of 628 officers, cadets and their family members joined the event.



- 10** **Family Fun Day 2018** was held on Sunday, 4 March 2018 at Wong Tai Sin Square and the Opening Ceremony was officiated by Mr. Syrus Tsui Cheuk-fung, Assistant District Officer (Wong Tai Sin).



The event aimed to deliver health message to the public, as well as to foster loving family relationship in the community. A series of activities was held by St. John members and supporting parties, including parent-child competition, stage performances, first aid demonstration, medical check-up services, game booths, ambulance and equipment display etc. Over 3,500 participants joined the event.

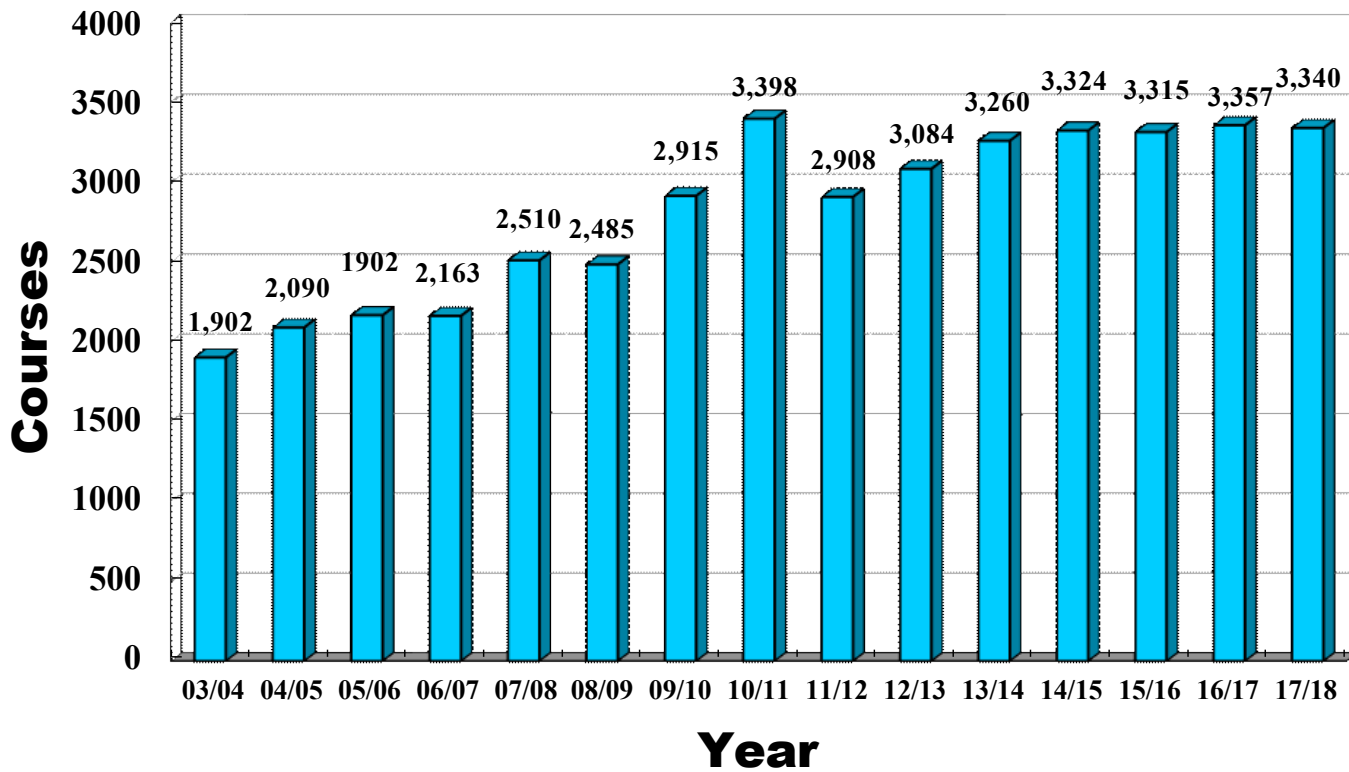

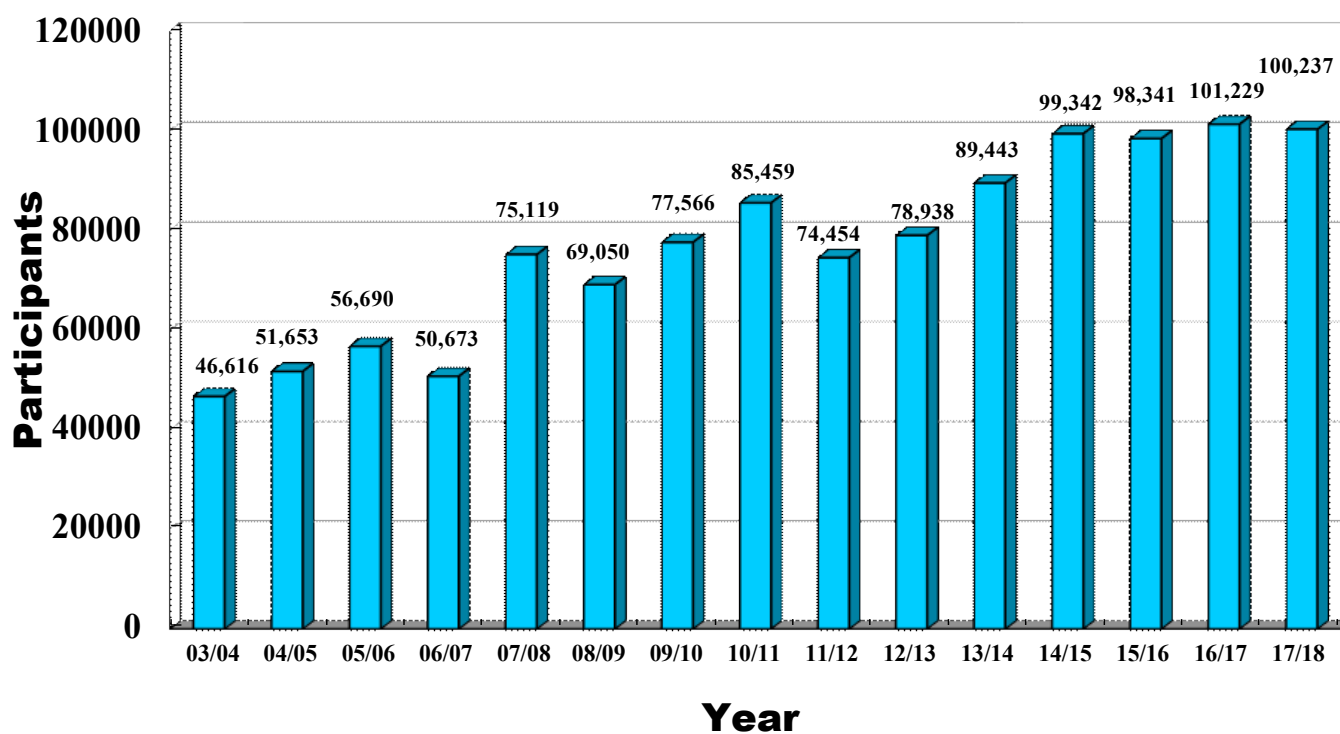

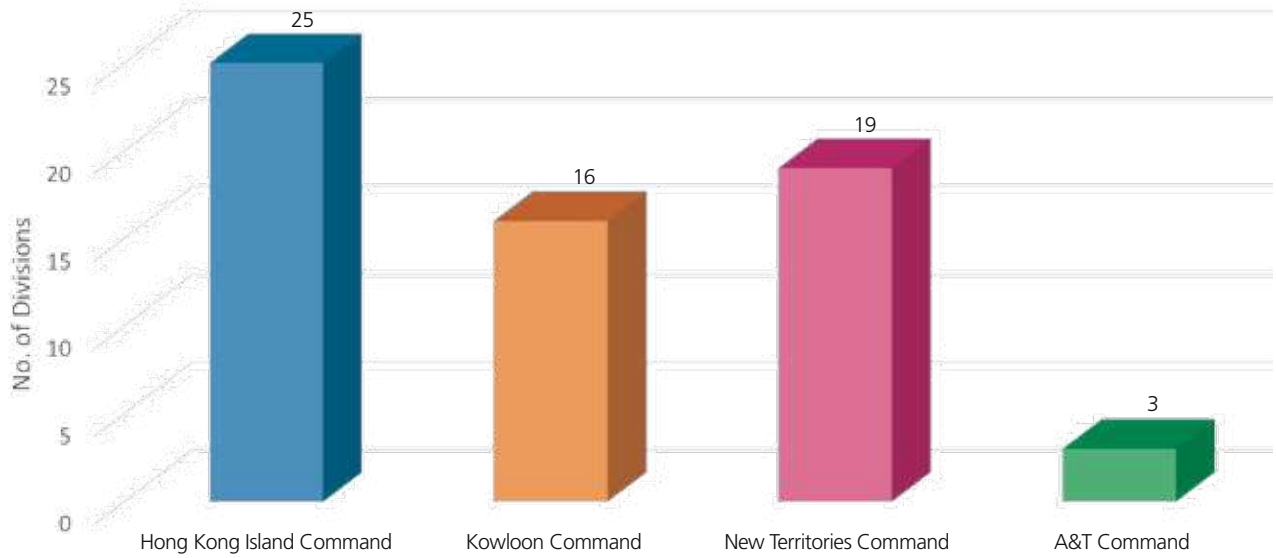
Total number of Training Courses conducted by the Association (2003–2018)



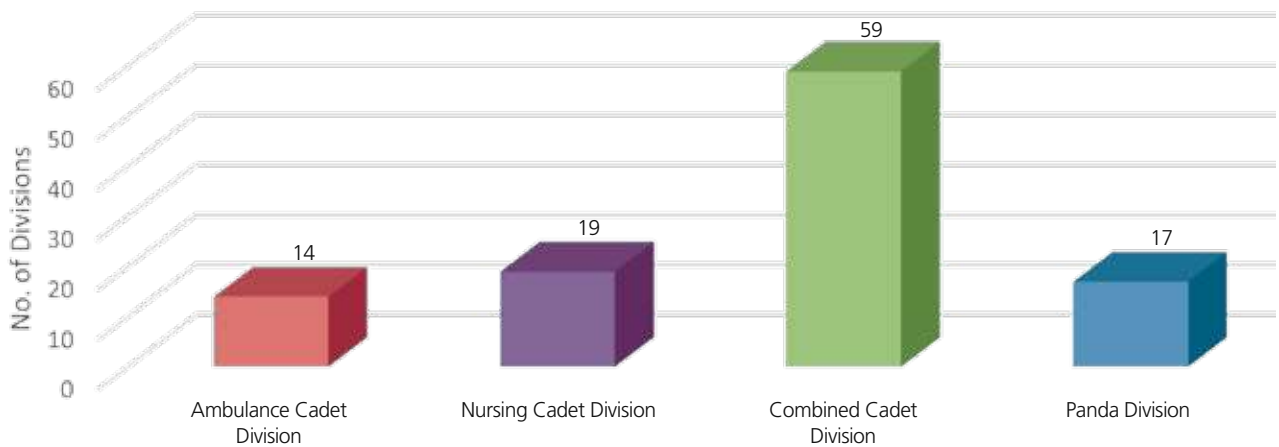
Total number of participants enrolled in Training Courses conducted during 2003–2018



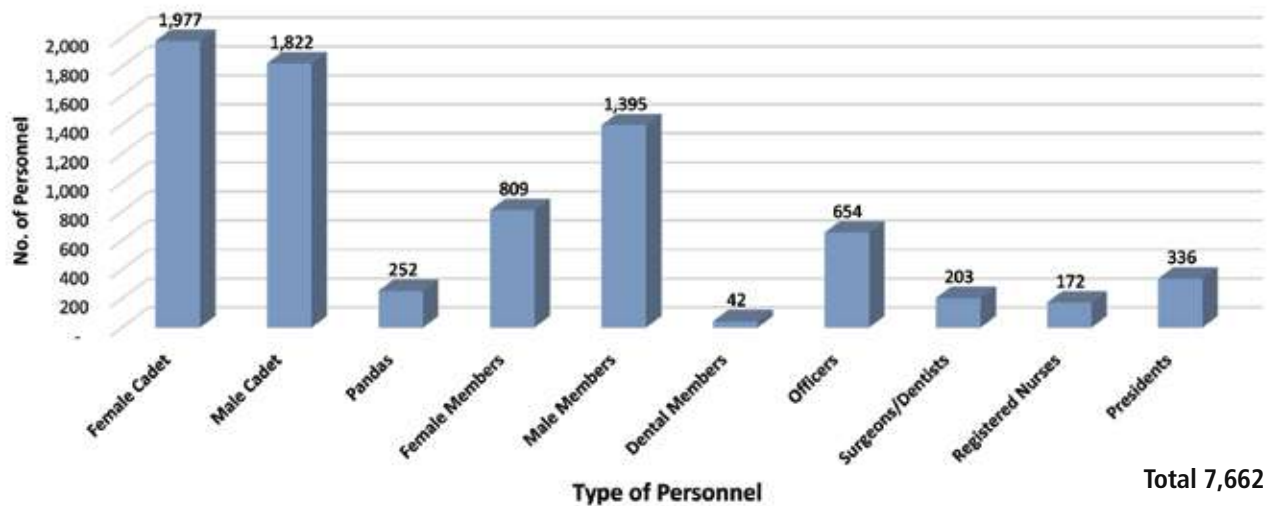
Number of Divisions in the Hong Kong Island / Kowloon / New Territories / Ambulance & Transport Command



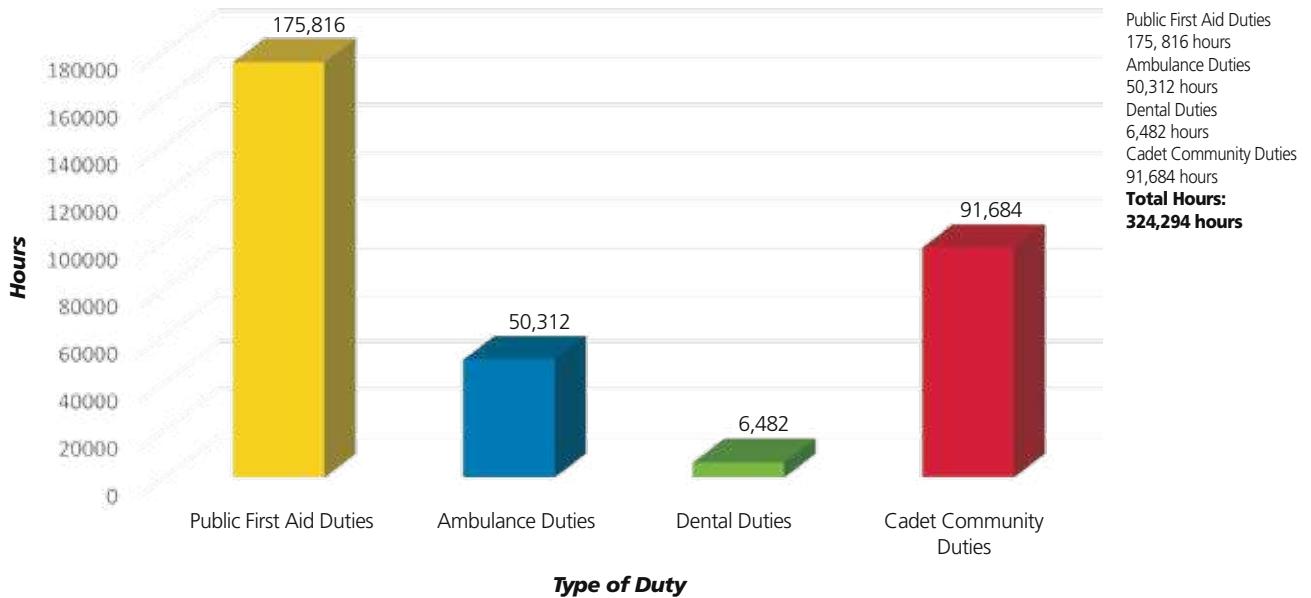
Number of Divisions in the Youth Command



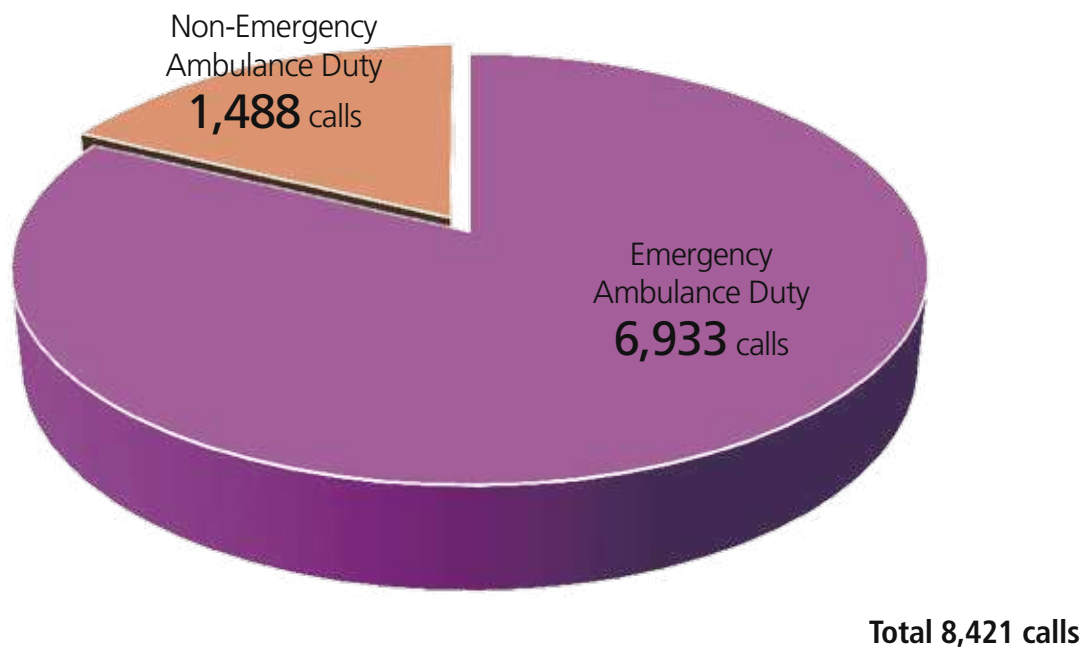
Strength of the Brigade as at 31 March 2018
