**Hong Kong St. John Ambulance** has been established in Hong Kong for 135 years. It was first started in 1884 in the name of “Hong Kong St. John Ambulance Association” and inaugurated in 1900. The **Brigade** was formally established in 1916 during World War I, followed by the establishment of the **Council** in 1949 after World War II. In 2015, Hong Kong was upgraded as a **Priory** of the Order of St. John. As an ex-officio member of the Grand Council of the Order, Hong Kong will now have a broader scope of involvement in international policies and activities.

St. John has been well-known in the provision of First Aid training and Ambulance services to the general public in Hong Kong. The principle and spirit of Hong Kong St. John Ambulance as embodied in the motto **“For the Service of Mankind”** remain unchanged after the enactment of the new **Hong Kong St. John Ambulance Incorporation Ordinance (Chapter 1164)** on 27 June 1997. Hong Kong St. John Ambulance continues in promoting and encouraging all works of humanity and charity for the relief of distress, suffering, sickness and danger without any distinction as to race, class or creed.

The **Council** is the supreme governing body of **Hong Kong St. John Ambulance** and is charged with the governance, management and control of all businesses and activities of the Corporation. The Council is composed of dedicated volunteers from various professions and the Assistant Director (Administration and Policy) of Department of Health also sits in the Council as an observer. The Council's work is facilitated by its standing Committees, namely, Two MacDonnell Road Management, Finance, Honours and Awards, Public Relations, Property Management and Development, Greater China Affairs and Ambulance Service Steering.

The **Association**, the training branch, has been the premier organization of the territory responsible for instructing members of the general public the principles and practice of First Aid, Home Nursing and allied subjects since 1884. The **Director's Conference** ensures that training works of the Association are conducted effectively and efficiently. There are 547 volunteer lecturers or instructors, including doctors, nurses and allied health professionals.

The **Brigade**, the service branch, is responsible for organizing training and equipping adult and youth members to undertake, on a voluntary basis, First Aid, Home Nursing and Ambulance Services to those in need. The service is free. The **Commissioner's Conference** is responsible for overseeing the organization, administration, services provision and development of the Brigade. At present, there are 7,680 members, made up of 3,538 Adult and 4,142 Youth members including 276 members from St. John Pandas.

The fiscal year 2018-2019 was another challenging year for the organization. Serving the community through the voluntary work of St. John has given me great pleasure, pride and satisfaction. I would like to express my sincere appreciation and heartfelt gratitude to my fellow Members of the Council for their unfailing trust, valuable advice and great support to my chairmanship, which are essential for meeting our challenges all along and ahead.

St. John is an organization with a long history and three distinctive characteristics – represented by the letter “Cs”. Christianity signifies our religious origin, Chivalry implies morality and nobleness, and Charity is our core business, mainly in the healthcare field.

This year, we have launched the e-payment system to facilitate members of the public to enroll in our training courses, resulting in much greater efficiency and popularity. We are actively preparing to launch on-line learning in order to facilitate and promote First Aid training. Hopefully, the pilot of on-line learning will be launched later this year. In addition, efforts are being made to gain accreditation of our training courses. Our “Certificate in First Aid” course gained 10 Level 3 Credit Points and our “Foundation Certificate in Care-related Support Worker Training” gained 8 Level 2 Credit Points from the Hong Kong Council for Accreditation of Academic & Vocational Qualifications, and more will come. We are now in full steam preparing for ISO 9001 – 2015 certification.

My dream is that everybody knows First Aid, both for the health of self and others. Schools are the ideal places of teaching First Aid, as the environments are more organized, the learning atmosphere more receptive and the impact more extended. A pilot of providing free Basic First Aid training to Primary 5 and 6 students was launched last year, and 68 primary schools with 3,892 students have enrolled. Certainly, this project will continue and will be extended to secondary schools.

In addition to recruiting primary school students as St. John Pandas to expand our membership, an Undergraduate Membership Program was launched this fiscal year to attract undergraduates into the Brigade. The primary aim is to provide an opportunity to local undergraduates to learn first aid and teamwork in order to better equip them to apply for jobs after graduation. The response was overwhelming with support from 8 educational institutions.

As “the ambulance is an expression of the spirit of the Order and the Order the soul of the ambulance”, ambulance staff have been transferred to the direct supervision of the Secretariat in order to maintain continuity and quality. Plans are in the pipeline to upgrade the training of our ambulance staff and quality of our ambulance service.

As a Priory of the Order of St. John, our activities should no longer be confined to our own locality. We continue to expand our networks and exchanges in the Mainland, Taiwan and Macau, and we have assisted in setting up PHTLS training centres in Kaohsiung, Guangzhou, and more. In addition, we are expected to support other St. John Associations as a global policy, to fulfill the mission and uphold the good name of the Order.

The achievement and success that have been made by Hong Kong St. John Ambulance would not be possible without the full dedication and commitment of our volunteers and staff, who have served conscientiously to uphold the highest tradition of St. John in every way. To them, I wish to express my sincere thankfulness and appreciation for their admirable work. In addition, the generosity and guidance of the Department of Health, Home Affairs Bureau, Hong Kong Jockey Club, Community Chest and other donors keep us on the right track to respond to the needs of our local community, enabling the continuation and expansion of our services and works.

I am confident that St. John will grow from strength to strength and strive to provide better services for the community. Glory goes to every member of Hong Kong St. John Ambulance.

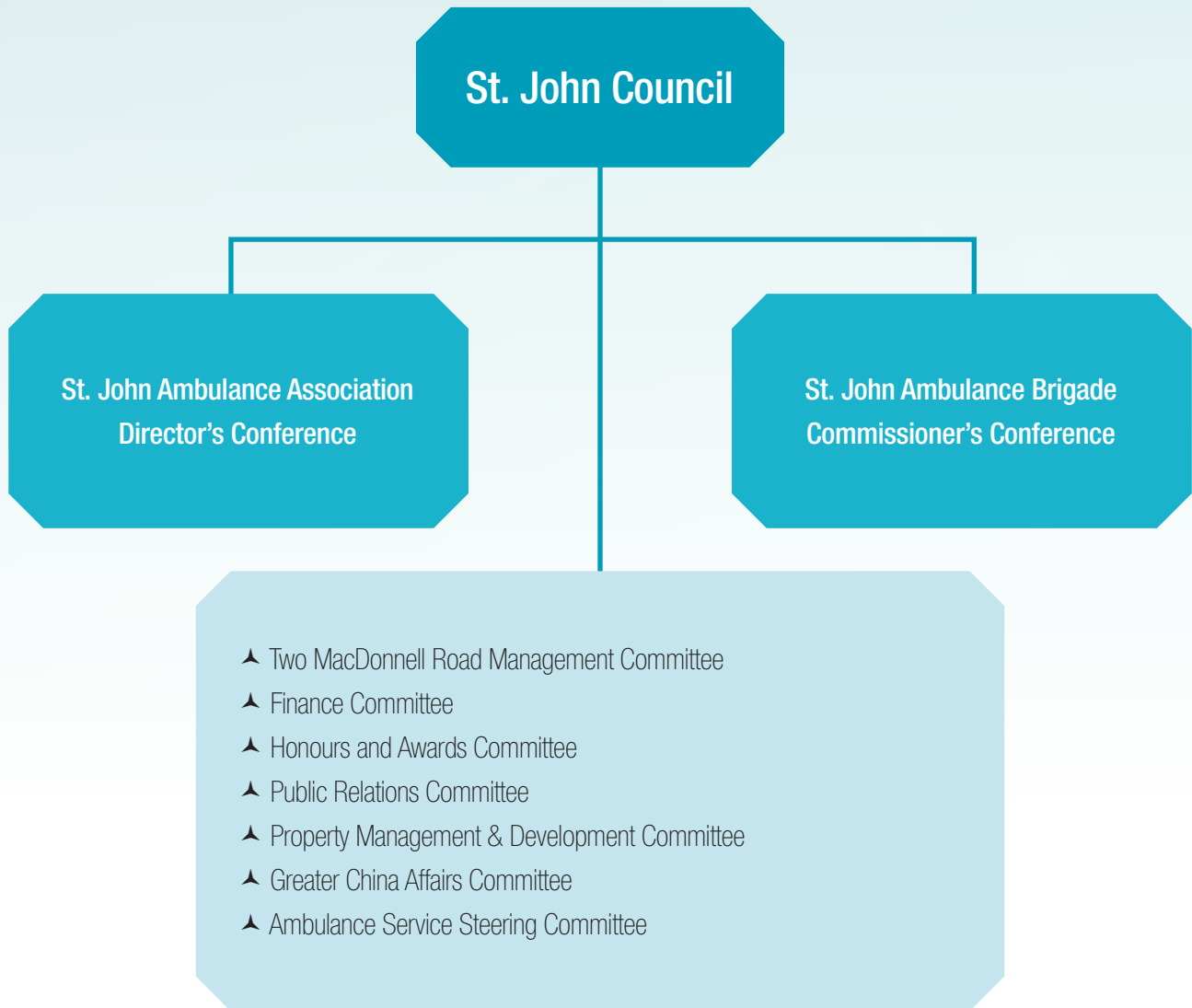

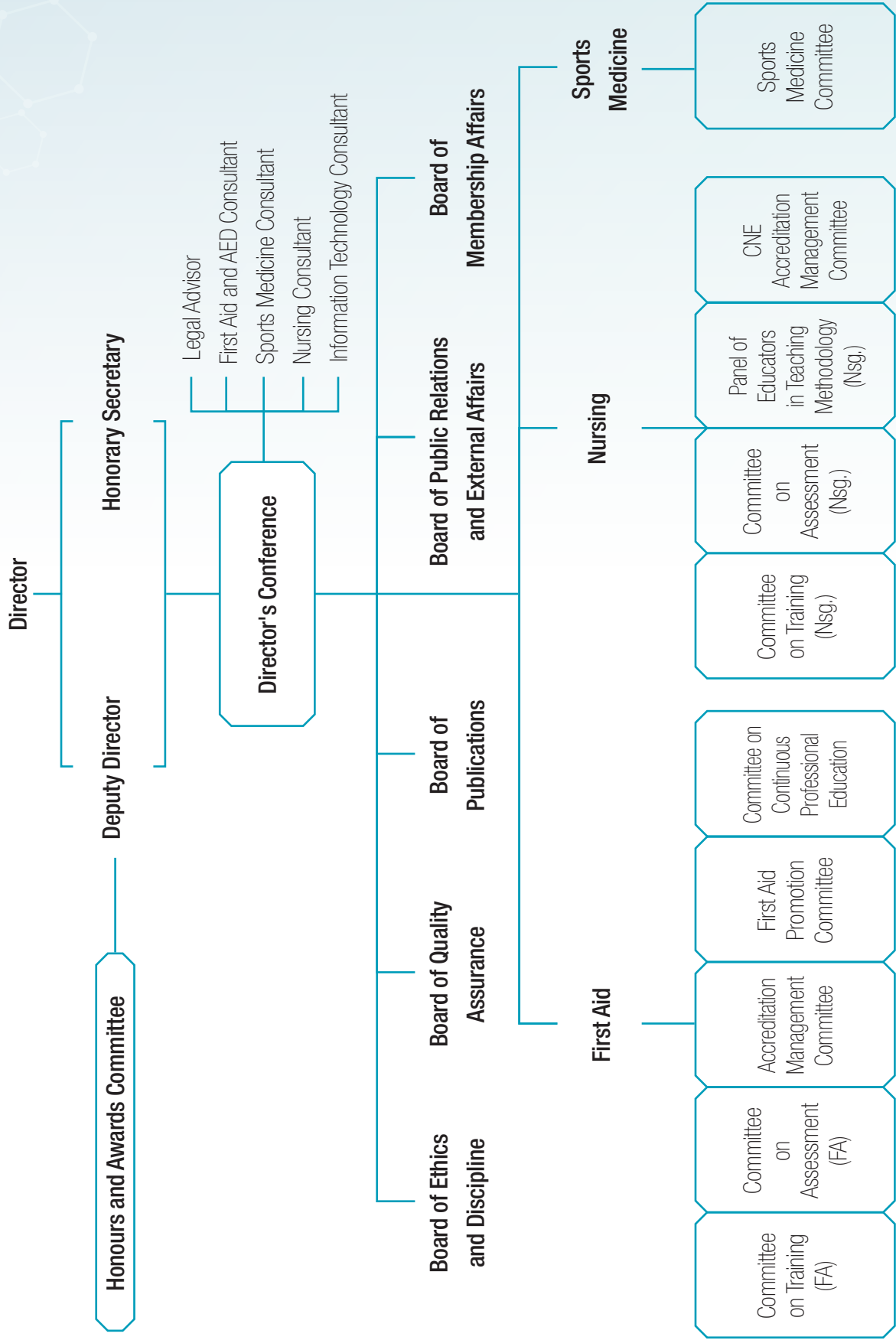

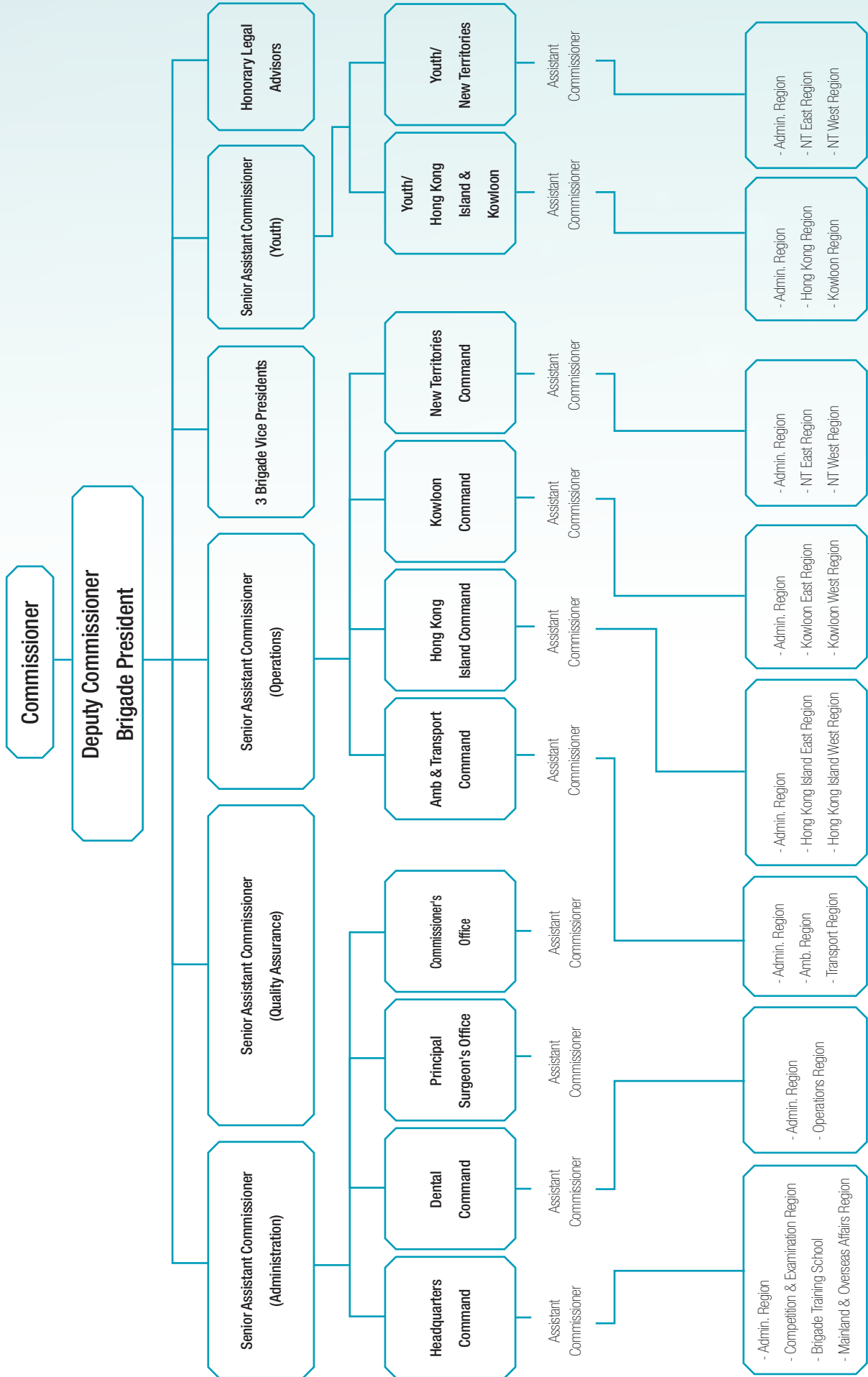

## HIGHLIGHTS OF THE YEAR

- 1** An **Investiture and Presentation of Prior's Commendation** was held at St. John's Cathedral on Saturday, 20 October 2018. The Prior of The St. John Priory of Hong Kong, Dr. Chung Chin-hung presented the St. John Insignia to 27 award recipients with 3 Commanders, 7 Officers and 17 Members who have been admitted to or promoted in the Order as a result of having demonstrated successfully their leadership, integrity and notable service to the organization.

Moreover, 2 Brigade Members received Prior's Commendation in recognition of their participation in a successful resuscitation of cardiac arrest through automated external defibrillation and cardiopulmonary resuscitation on 22 April 2018.



- 2** **Grand Council Meeting 2018** was held at Williamsburg, USA from 23-25 May 2018. Dr. Chung Chin-hung, Prior of The St. John Priory of Hong Kong, and Ms. Susanna Chow Chui-san, Chief Executive Officer attended the meeting. It was a fruitful meeting in many ways. The Council had discussions on many topics of common concern for St. John worldwide, the main theme being the "Nature of the Order".

**3** With dedication to serve the community and to equip youngsters for first aid knowledge and skills, St. John has launched a 16-hour free **First Aid Training Programme (Primary School)** [學校急救課程計劃 (小學)] for Primary 5 and 6 students. To facilitate the training process, a train-the-trainer workshop was conducted for St. John Lecturers on 20 June 2018. The programme has been commenced since 28 June 2018. Over 3,892 participants have received basic first aid training, course manuals, certificates and bandage packs free of charge.



**4** In order to commemorate the **70<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Hong Kong St. John Ambulance Brigade Youth Command**, a series of celebration events were organized in 2018. The Kick-off Ceremony was held on Saturday, 28 July 2018 at Hong Kong St. John Ambulance Headquarters. Mr. Jack Chan Jick-chi, JP, Under Secretary for Home Affairs Bureau officiated the ceremony. More than 200 guests including Heads of the Uniformed Groups, Principals of secondary schools and St. John members attended the event.



- An **Exchange Tour** to Malaysia was organized from 9 to 14 August 2018. A total of 140 Officers and Cadets joined the tour. The visits to the ambulance depot in Kuala Lumpur and cadet divisions in Penang had enhanced the understanding of St. John Malaysia as well as the friendship between members of St. John in Hong Kong and Malaysia.



- A **Symposium** was held on Saturday, 27 October 2018 at Aw Boon Haw Hall of Hong Kong St. John Ambulance Headquarters. Professor Daniel Shek Tan-lei, Professor of the Hong Kong Polytechnic University officiated the Opening Ceremony. Mr. Lau Ming-wai, Vice-Chairman of Youth Development Commission and Dr. Esther Ho Yuk-fan, Principal of Carmel Alison Lam Foundation Secondary School also gave keynote speeches in the seminar. Over 120 participants joined the event.

The Presentation Ceremony was held on Saturday, 10 November 2018 at Garden of Life, Kowloon Park and officiated by Professor Sophia Chan Siu-chee, JP, Secretary for Food and Health and Dr. Constance Chan Hon-ye, JP, Director of Health.

- 6 The Queen Elizabeth Foundation for the Mentally Handicapped** sponsored Hong Kong St. John Ambulance with the total amount of HK\$740,000 for purchasing a new dental van, two mobile dental units and dental instruments. This newly equipped dental van can accommodate 2 wheelchairs which is a great asset for the dental team to perform outreach dental services to the special need patients at their care centers or for transporting them back to the fully equipped clinic at St. John Ambulance Headquarters. The key handover ceremony was held on Wednesday, 5 September 2018 at St. John Tower. Mr. Herman Hui Chung-shing, SBS, BBS, MH, JP, Chairman of the Council of the Queen Elizabeth Foundation for the Mentally Handicapped was invited to be the Officiating Guest of the Ceremony.



- 7 The Hong Kong St. John Ambulance Association Annual Awards Presentation Ceremony and Dinner** was held on Saturday, 3 November 2018 at Maxim's Palace, Tsuen Wan. Professor Sophia Chan Siu-chee, JP, Secretary for Food and Health was invited as the Officiating Guest. Around 300 St. John Lecturers, Instructors and guests attended the ceremony.



- 8 The Annual Parade of Brigade** was held on Sunday, 25 November 2018 at Victoria Park, Causeway Bay, Hong Kong. The Honourable Mrs. Carrie Lam Cheng Yuet-ngor, GBM, GBS, The Chief Executive of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region cum President of Hong Kong St. John Ambulance was invited as the Reviewing Officer to inspect the Brigade and present the competition trophies to the winning units.



9 In order to strengthen the disaster emergency management skills of paramedic staff and to establish a closer collaboration within cross strait, Hong Kong St. John Ambulance jointly organized **“The Cross Strait Disaster Emergency Medical Rescue Forum and Workshop”** ( 兩岸四地災害醫學救援論壇暨工作坊 ) with Chinese Society of Cardiothoracic and Vasculanesthesiology from 21 to 25 November 2018 at St. John Tower, Hong Kong. Over 180 participants including medical professionals from the Mainland, Hong Kong, Macau and Taiwan, close counterparts from prehospital and rescuing bodies in Hong Kong attended the Forum and Workshop.



10 The St. John Ambulance Association was granted an award, **“ERB 課程管理獎”** in the Employees Retraining Board (ERB) Annual Award Presentation Ceremony 2018-19 held on Saturday, 5 January 2019 at Southorn Stadium. The Association



has been conducting health-related courses in collaboration with ERB for over 20 years. Popular courses including Foundation Certificate in Care-related Support Worker Training, Foundation Certificate in Integrated First Aid Training and Certificate in Health Worker Training were all well received by participants.

11 In order to strengthen the connection and communication with agency members, **The Hong Kong Council of Social Service** has launched the Governance Platform Project since mid-2016 to share and exchange ideas with agency board members on governance issues. A courtesy visit to Hong Kong St. John Ambulance was held on Tuesday, 8 January 2019. Members found this a fruitful meeting with lots of exchange in views on some issues of common concern.



- 12 **The Secretary for Home Affairs' (SHA) Commendation Scheme** aims at offering recognition of special achievements to individual volunteer leaders of Uniformed Groups under the purview of SHA in youth development works.

Senior Superintendent Ho Lai-pun and Superintendent Chan Ngai-yeung of Youth Command were awarded the Volunteer Leader Commendation. Senior Ambulance Officer Lam Ka-lok and Ambulance Officer Ma Yuet-ting were awarded the Youth Volunteer Leader Commendation in recognition of their outstanding and continuous contribution in youth works through the Hong Kong St. John Ambulance Brigade Youth Command. The Presentation Ceremony was held on Monday, 28 January 2019 at the Central Government Office.



- 13 The **Hong Kong St. John Ambulance Annual Dinner** was held on Sunday, 10 March 2019 at BP International, Kowloon. Under the competent chairmanship of Mr. Alfred Poon Sun-biu, Brigade Commissioner and Dr. Donald Li Kwok-tung, Association Director (represented by Dr. David Lee Ka-yan), the feedback was overwhelming.



43 tables were taken up and over 500 members of St. John and guests from close counterparts attended.

- 14 A group of 14 Officers of **St. John Ambulance of Malaysia** led by Dato' Lai See-ming, Council Chairman and Commander-in-Chief of St. John Ambulance of Malaysia paid a courtesy visit to The St. John Priory of Hong Kong from 7 to 11 March 2019. The group visited the Hong Kong St. John Ambulance Headquarters, Hong Kong Island Command Headquarters, St. John Ambulance Control Centre and Wong Tai Sin Temple. Demonstration on a variety of courses and the Special Task Force were arranged for the guests.



## Service Reports

1. During the reporting year, the Brigade discharged a total of 314,261 man-hours of volunteer first aid, ambulance duties, dental and community services for the public.
2. In 2018/2019, the Brigade responded to 8,035 emergency and non-emergency calls for ambulance services. A detailed breakdown of these calls is tabulated below for reference.

### 3. Dental Service

The Dental Service provided by Hong Kong St John Ambulance Brigade has been in operation for over 68 years. This is the only service provided among the global St. John Ambulance organizations.

Free dental service is made available to the elderly and patients with special needs by Brigade volunteer dental surgeons, dental surgery assistants and members at the Dental Clinic located at the St. John Headquarters or to the elderly homes by the Outreach Team. In addition, oral health services are provided to the public through campaigns and special events.

In 2018/2019, volunteers in Dental Command provided dental services to a total of 1,214 patients, out of whom 2,424 cases were treated in the dental clinic. In addition, 2,691 members of the general public received free consultations and free basic dental treatment including oral examination, dental prophylaxis, fillings and extractions through various health promotional projects.

## Trainings

- **For the Public/Organizations**

### 1. **Advanced Medical Life Support (AMLS) Course**

The Association has launched the Advanced Medical Life Support (AMLS) course developed by the National Association of Emergency Medical Technicians (NAEMT) of the United States since 2016. Apart from the didactic aspects, interactive simulations and problem solving scenarios have given participants realistic exposure to similar cases. Course participants were mainly doctors and nurses. In 2018, four AMLS courses were conducted between April and October with 53 participants attended.



### 2. **Advanced Life Support in Obstetrics (ALSO)**

ALSO provider courses were jointly organized by the Hong Kong College of Emergency Medicine and the Hong Kong College of Obstetricians & Gynaecologists were held for the 8<sup>th</sup> consecutive year at St. John Tower. Three ALSO courses were conducted on 10-11 April, 12-13 April, 16-17 April 2018 at St. John Tower with 100 nurses and doctors participated.



### 3. Sports Emergencies Update Workshop and 10th Anniversary Celebrating Event

The First Aid Specialty Course on Sports Emergencies has been launched for 10 years. The course covers the care of common injuries and other elements of First Aid crucial to sports, which enable candidates to respond to emergency First Aid situations when participating in sports.

The Sports Medicine Committee published a Sports Manual in June 2017 for the public and other interested parties, especially those working in sports and recreation areas. To facilitate the instructors in course delivery and give credits to volunteer doctors, lecturers and instructors for their professional advice and assistance, the Committee conducted an Update Workshop cum 10th Anniversary Dinner on Sunday, 29 April 2018. Dr. Chung Chin-hung, Council Chairman and Dr. David Lee Ka-yan, Association Deputy Director attended the dinner and celebrated with 60 St. John Instructors.



### 4. Basic Life Support in Obstetrics (BLSO™ ) Provider Course

The American Academy of Family Physicians has granted the Association a license of conducting Basic Life Support in Obstetrics (BLSO™) Provider Course. The course objective is to provide training of pre-hospital care providers who wish to increase their knowledge and skills in the field of emergency delivery. Courses were held between April and June 2018. Candidate who has passed the assessment would be awarded a certificate valid for 5 years.



### 5. Free Cardio-Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and Automated External Defibrillation (AED) Training Courses for Members of the Public

The Sir Robert Ho Tung Charitable Fund had granted the Association funding for the 9<sup>th</sup> consecutive year for conducting free 6-hour CPR & AED training for members of the public. The project was conducted from 3 May 2018 to 22 June 2018 with 2,003 participants attended.



## 6. Mass Transit Railway (MTR) First Aid Competition 2018

Since 2012, MTR has invited the Association to organize First Aid Competitions to enhance the level of competence of MTR staff in emergency situations. In 2018, the competition was conducted on 16 May 2018 at Fo Tan MTR Depot. An Emergency Physician, Dr. Leung Chin-san and an Assistant Training Manager led a team of seven First Aid Lecturers to act as judges in the competition. Altogether 24 teams, totaling 80 members, participated in the competition by applying first aid skills in designated scenarios and timeframe.



## 7. Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and Automated External Defibrillation (AED) Education Project of Rotary

With the sponsorship of Rotary International District 3450, the Association conducted the Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and Automated External Defibrillation (AED) course for members of the public for the third year. In 2018, the targeted beneficiaries were students and school staff. The Opening Ceremony of the third phase was held on Saturday, 29 September 2018 at St. John Tower. Dr. Wong Ka-hing, JP, Controller of Centre for Health Protection was invited as Officiating Guest of the ceremony. Brigade members were also invited to attend the event and shared their experience of a case of successfully saving the life of a sudden cardiac arrest patient by applying an AED machine. Ten courses were conducted from July 2018 to March 2019 and 453 participants were trained.



## 8. Pre-hospital Trauma Life Support (PHTLS) Courses

The Association has become the sole provider of PHTLS courses in Hong Kong since 2002. The course was developed by the National Association of Emergency Medical Technicians (NAEMT) of the United States and was introduced to Hong Kong by the China-Hong Kong Chapter of the American College of Surgeons. This two-day intensive course gives instructions on kinematics of injuries, assessment and management of trauma patients with multiple injuries. Prospective trainees include doctors, nurses and pre-hospital care providers.

The demand for PHTLS courses has been increasing rapidly. NAEMT authorized St. John to conduct the first PHTLS course for 上海長海醫院技能中心 from 30 to 31 May 2018. A total of 29 Emergency Room doctors passed the assessment. Among them, 19 doctors attended the Instructor Course held on 1 June 2018 and 6 of them were qualified to take part in the instructor monitoring in Guangzhou.



The Association was invited by the Family Medicine (FM) and Primary Healthcare Department (PHC) of the Department of Health to demonstrate the knowledge and skills of PHTLS and AED on 2 May 2018. The First Aid & AED Consultant, Dr. Lit Chau-hung led a team to deliver a brief introduction of PHTLS to the doctors of FM & PHC.



A PHTLS course was conducted for House of Dancing Water in Macau on 9 and 16 January 2019, with 20 participants attended the course and passed the assessment.



## 9. First Aid Lecturer Training Course (LTC) 2018/2019

The LTC aimed at training up sufficient volunteers for the Association to teach the general public on First Aid. The candidates have to go through various assessments, i.e. First Aid knowledge and practical assessment etc. Twenty-four candidates were admitted in the LTC 2018/2019. The course commenced on 3 September 2018.



## 10. Wong Tai Sin District Healthy & Safe City

The Association was invited by Wong Tai Sin District Healthy & Safe City to attend the 「防火救心樂安康」 on Saturday, 1 December 2018 at Wong Tai Sin Temple Court and Wong Tai Sin Square. St. John Lecturers (First Aid) demonstrated CPR and AED to strengthen community awareness of sudden cardiac death.



## 11. Pet First Aid and Emergency Care Course (PETFA)

The Pet First Aid and Emergency Care Course was launched in 2015, and has grown in popularity since the first class. In 2018, group courses were conducted for various organizations, namely, Agriculture, Fisheries and Conservation Department, Customs Detector Dog Unit, Police Dog Unit, Hong Kong Institute of Technology and Exhibition Group etc.



## 12. Basic Psychological Life Support (BPLS) Instructor Course 2018/2019

In view of the shortage of Psychiatric doctor and nurse to teach BPLS, a BPLS Instructor course was conducted on 5 January 2019. Dr. Bonnie Siu Wei-man of Castle Peak Hospital was invited to be a guest speaker for the course. Six candidates attended the course and four were qualified as instructors after monitored teaching.



## 13. Re-accreditation of Certificate in First Aid Course (AFA) – QF Level 3

The 30-hour Certificate in First Aid was granted accreditation status at Quality Framework (QF) Level 3 from the Hong Kong Council for Accreditation of Academic and Vocational Qualifications (HKCAAVQ) in 2015. The AFA has been re-accredited by HKCAAVQ under the Qualification Framework (QF) in 2018, with validity until 30 September 2021.

## • For Lecturers/Instructors and Members

### 1. Seminar on Quality Teaching

In order to enhance the quality on teaching, a seminar was conducted on Wednesday, 27 June 2018. During the seminar, Dr. Chau Chi-wai, Chairman of Board of Quality Assurance shared the recent result of course evaluations and complaint cases with the Lecturers/Instructors. He had reviewed the complaint handling procedures according to the past cases to introduce the Rules & Regulations of the Association to the Lecturers/Instructors.

Dr. Chan Tsan-ming, Chairman of Accreditation Management Committee provided the Lecturers/Instructors with effective teaching methods and the approach towards a new group of young people during the class. The seminar was conducted with enthusiastic discussions on enhancing the teaching quality among Lecturers/Instructors.



### 2. Continuing Nursing Education (CNE) Talks

CNE Accreditation Management Committee conducted health related talks to update and develop knowledge and skills for St. John Lecturers and Instructors. In 2018/19, 「精神科服務以復元模式推行的探索」、 「親子由愛的撫摩開始」、 「香薰治療與你息息相關」 and 「香港的中醫護理發展概況」 were conducted and a total of 7 CNE points were offered.

### 3. Automated External Defibrillation (AED) Instructor Course 2018/19

An enrichment course for St. John Lecturers was conducted on Sunday, 10 March 2019 which offered AED Instructor training for the existing First Aid Lecturers.

1. Representatives from Hong Kong St. John Ambulance attended the 21<sup>st</sup> Annual Congress of the Chinese Society of Emergency Medicine ( 中華醫學會急診醫學分會第 21 次全國急診醫學學術年會 ) from 2 to 5 August 2018 in Tianjin.
2. Representatives from Hong Kong St. John Ambulance attended the Annual Conference of the Emergency Medical Center (First Aid Station) Branch for Chinese Hospital Association ( 中國醫院協會急救中心 ( 站 ) 管理分會第三屆委員會換屆大會暨第四屆委員會第一次全體委員 ) from 23 to 25 August 2018 in Beijing.
3. An Exchange Tour with two-day training course to Dongchuan, Yunnan Province ( 雲南省東川地區交流團 ) was organized from 23 to 27 March 2019.

## Special Programs

1. The **May Fourth Flag Raising Ceremony** is held every year at Golden Bauhinia Square to commemorate the May Fourth Movement. Cadet Leader Chan Lai-tan from Po Leung Kuk Tong Nai Kan Combined Division and Corporal Chung Hoi-yan from Chan Kai Combined Division won the First Runner Up in the selection and they were responsible to raise the HKSAR flag in the ceremony on 4 May 2018.



2. The **Annual Service of Rededication** was held at St. John's Cathedral on Sunday, 17 June 2018. Mr. Lam Kwok-leung, CSDSM, Commissioner of Correctional Services attended the Service and read the Second Lesson.



3. **Social Welfare Activities**

The Association co-organized with Sik Sik Yuen and SPARK of Life conducted a visit 「同心關愛護老逍遙遊」 to Ho Shin Home for the Elderly on Sunday, 24 June 2018. About 30 volunteers along with 18 staff of the elderly home accompanied 7 elders to enjoy an afternoon tea with sea view at Hong Kong Science Park. The visit brought joy to the elders and helped them felt being cared and respected.



- The **HK Uniformed Groups 10,000 miles Friendship Trek** is a cultural exchange program jointly organized by the Hong Kong Uniformed Youth Groups and Liaison Office of the Central People's Government, HKSAR. Participants of the program are youth members from all Uniformed Groups in Hong Kong. One Officer and seven Cadet Members of the Youth Command joined the 9-day Exchange Program at Foshan, Guilin, Yangso, Duyun, Kaili, Pingtang and Guiyang from 21 to 29 July 2018. The group attended the Flag Raising Ceremony and participated in tour to learn more about China, our homeland.



## 5. **Xian Exchange Programme 2018**

With the aim to promote communication and cultural exchange with the youth and young people in Mainland China, Youth Command organized a Xian Exchange Program from 19 to 24 July 2018. Three Officers and twenty Cadet Members from the Youth Command joined the 6-day Exchange Program with the aim to enhance understanding on academic studies, career and personal development as well as the future development of Hong Kong which is closely related to China.



- Cadets' Summer Camp 2018** was a major annual Youth Command event and was held from 3 to 5 August 2018 at Sai Kung Outdoor Recreation Centre, and it attracted over 280 Cadet Members to participate. Through multiple activities held in the summer camp including talks, competitions, campfire and various sports activities, Cadet Members could develop positive attitudes, self-confidence and a sense of belonging.



7. As an initiative to promote national education, young people were given the opportunity to conduct **Flag-Raising Ceremony at Golden Bauhinia Square**. Youth participating in this program were recommended by leaders from various Uniformed Groups and received specialized training for conducting the ceremony at Golden Bauhinia Square. The Scheme has been conducted on the second Sunday of each month since 2008 and St. John Youth Command was responsible for the flag-raising on Sunday, 14 October 2018.



8. **The Brigade Long Service Medals Presentation Ceremony 2018** was held at Pui Ching Primary School on Sunday, 18 November 2018. Altogether 335 recipients including Brigade Officers/Presidents/Surgeons/Members attended the Ceremony.



9. **Brigade Remembrance Sunday Service 2018** was held on Sunday, 11 November 2018 at the St. John War Memorial, Wong Nai Chung Gap in memory of the 56 Officers and Members who died in 1941 during the World War II. Council Chairman, Brigade Senior Management, guests and around 180 St. John personnel attended the Service.



# Special Programs

10. **Panda Orienteering Competition 2018** was held on Sunday, 18 November 2018 at the Pak Tam Chung Holiday Camp. A total of 229 Panda Members and their family members attended the camp. Through participating in the event, they can nurture their civic awareness, deepen their understanding of Hong Kong and enhance their connection with St. John through the competition.



11. In order to develop the St. John team spirit and promote physical fitness among Cadet Members, **Cadets' Touch Rugby Competition 2018** was held on Sunday, 23 December 2018 at King's Park Sports Ground. A total of 320 officers, cadets and their family members joined the event.



12. **Hong Kong Streetathon 2019** was held on Sunday, 13 January 2019. Over 140 St. John personnel were deployed to provide first aid and ambulance standby service at the event. There was a successful life-saving case by using AED on spot by St. John members.



13. **The Undergraduate Membership Program** aims at providing opportunity to the local undergraduate students to learn first aid and the importance of teamwork in order to better equip them to apply for jobs under the public sectors and disciplinary forces after graduation. The response was overwhelming with 154 applications received and 8 educational institutions had consented to be supporting partners.

A Kick-off Ceremony was launched on Saturday, 19 January 2019. Professor Simon Ho Shun-man, President of The Hang Seng University of Hong Kong officiated at the ceremony.



14. A **Health Promotion Day on 《少鹽、少糖、少·確幸》** organized by the Food and Health Bureau was held on Saturday, 23 February 2019 at Tai Kwun of Central. St. John Surgeons' Band was invited to conduct the singing performance. Meanwhile, two booths were set up for promoting CPR, AED and members recruitment.



15. **The Formula E** (ePrix Hong Kong Station), organized by the Hong Kong Automobile Association under the authority of Federation Internationale de l'Automobile, was convened for the third time in Hong Kong on 9 & 10 March 2019 in Central. This was the second time Hong Kong St John Ambulance Brigade was invited to provide First Aid and ambulance standby service for both the racing teams and spectators. A total of 8 ambulances, 2 for spectators, 4 for the track and 2 on the outskirts were deployed standby. 5 First Aid posts were also set up at strategic locations.



16. **Family Fun Day 2019** was held on Sunday, 10 March 2019 at Hing Fong Road Playground and the Opening Ceremony was officiated by Mr. Law King-shing, BBS, MH, Chairman of Kwai Tsing District Council.

The event aimed at delivering health messages to the public, as well as to foster loving family relationship in the community. A series of activities was held by St. John members and supporting parties, including parent-child competition, stage performances, first aid demonstration, medical check-up services, game booths, ambulance and equipment display etc. Over 2,000 participants joined the event.



17. **Cadets' Enrollment Ceremony and Passing-out Parade 2019** was held on Sunday, 17 March 2019 at the Hong Kong Auxiliary Police Headquarters. Mr. Yang Joe-tsi, Commandant of Hong Kong Auxiliary Police Force officiated at the ceremony and parade. About 500 secondary school students formally enrolled as St. John Cadet Members participated in this event. Mr. Yang delivered his speech to cadet and encouraged them to take part actively in extra-curricular activities and contribute their spare time to serve the community.



## 18. Publicity in various Local Media

- The Association was invited to provide a special series on first aid knowledge for **TVB Pleasure & Leisure Programme** 《都市閒情》 which were published from March to April 2018. The first and second series were presented by Dr. Lit Chau-hung, First Aid & AED Consultant of the Association on the topic of 「預防老人家居意外篇」 and 「心肺復甦去顫法篇」. The third series was presented by Dr. Li Wilson, Sports Medicine Consultant of the Association and Mr. Oscar Chan Ka-yu, Registered Physiotherapist on the topic of 「預防及處理運動受傷篇」. The fourth series was presented by Dr. David Lee Ka-yan, Association Deputy Director on the topic of 「幼兒常見意外篇」.



- The Association was invited to demonstrate CPR and AED skills and illustrate relevant knowledge at the programme 《香港新視點》 of Phoenix TV on 12 March 2019.

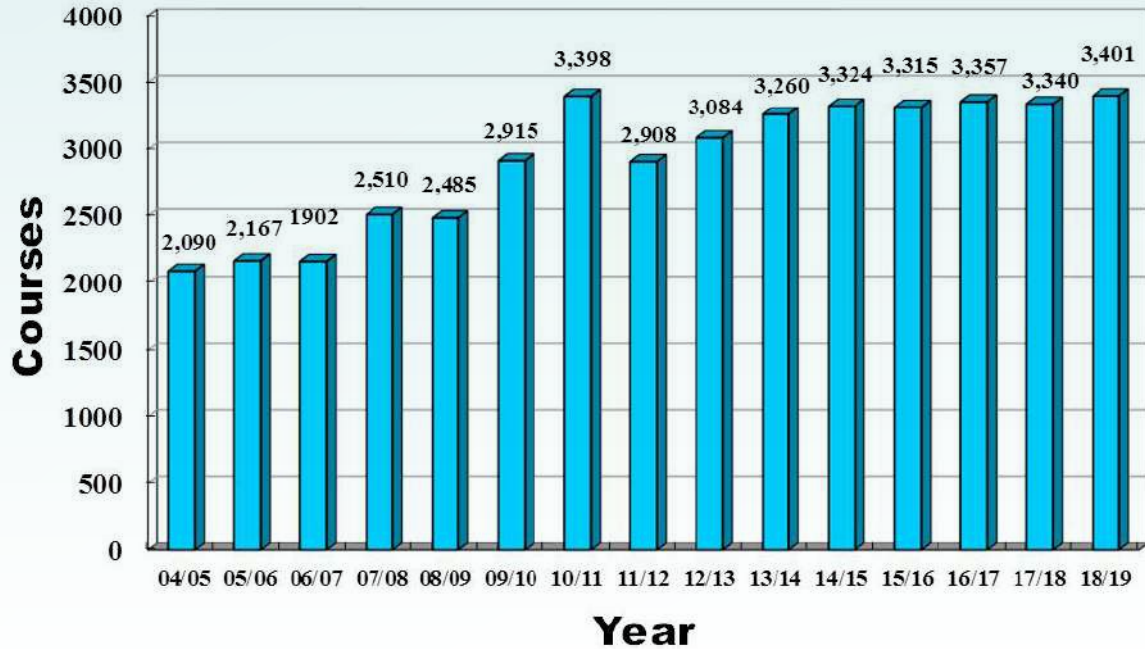

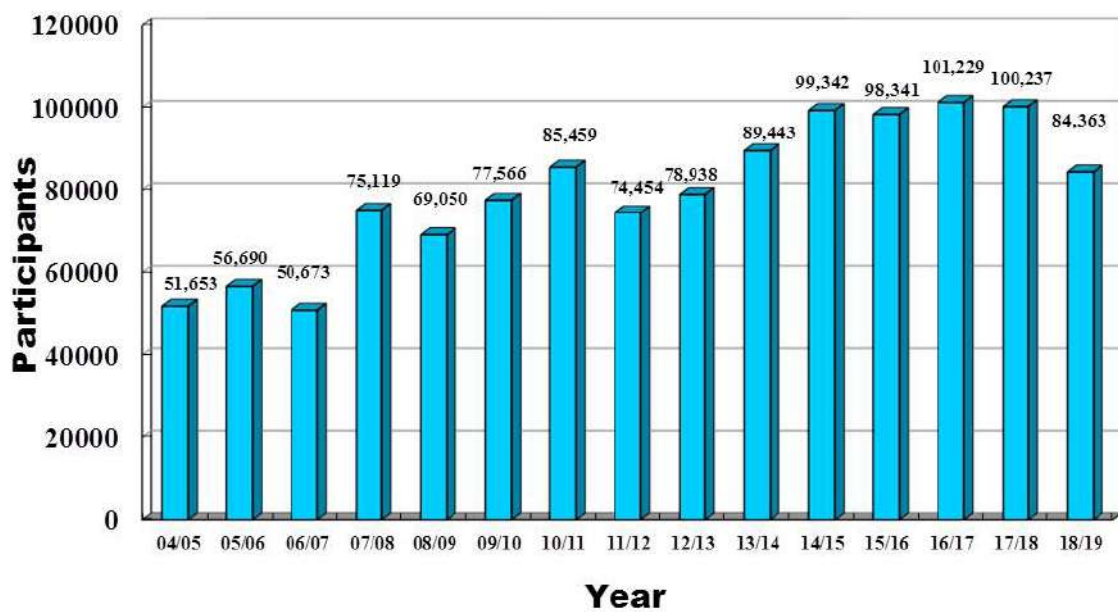

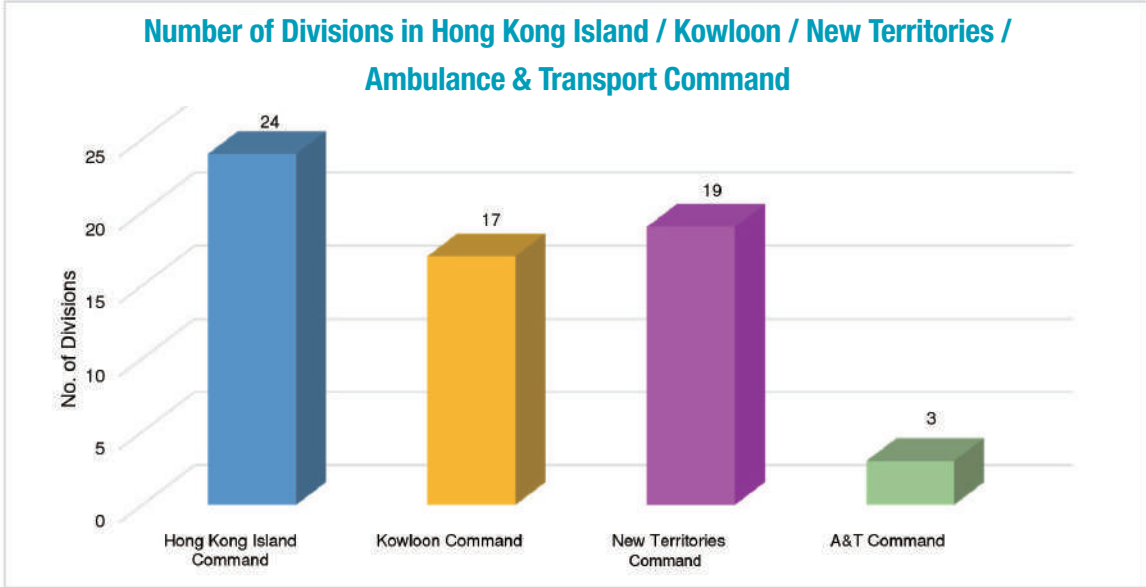
## Total number of Training Courses conducted by the Association (2004 - 2019)



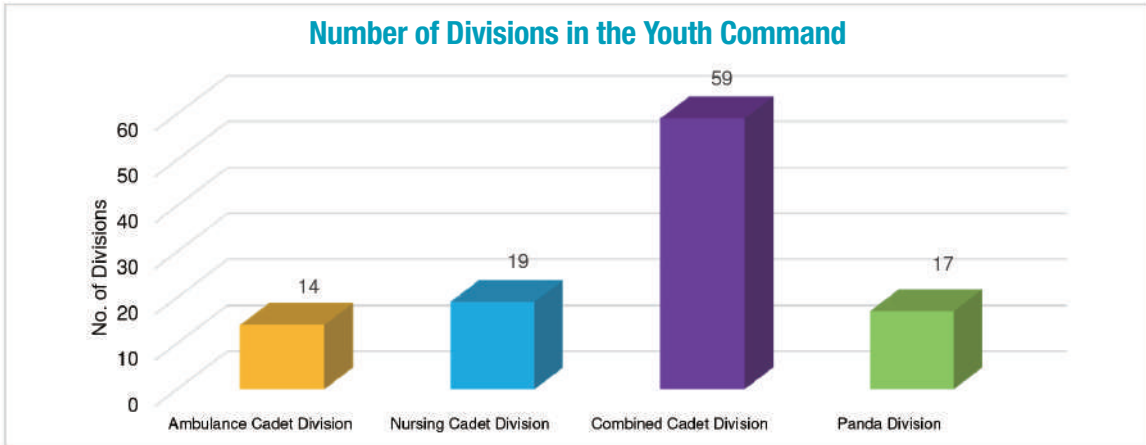
## Total number of participants enrolled in Training Courses conducted (2004 - 2019)



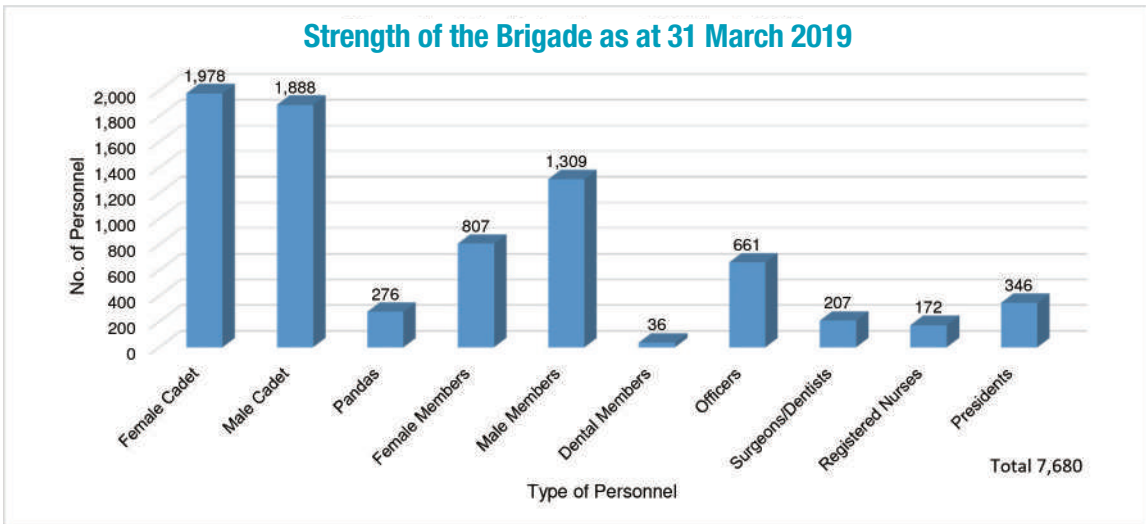
### Number of Divisions in Hong Kong Island / Kowloon / New Territories / Ambulance & Transport Command



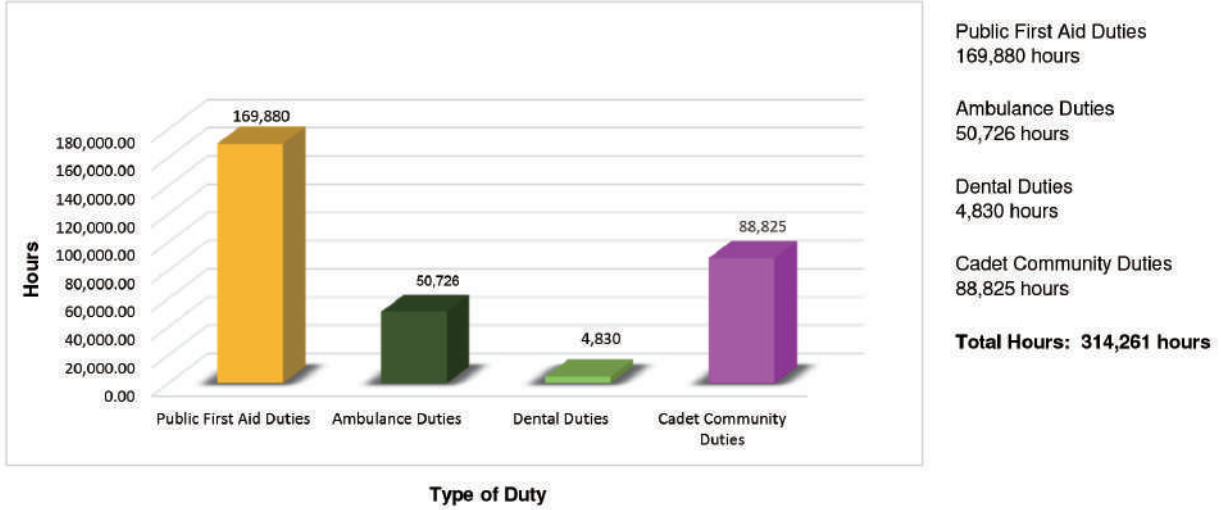
### Number of Divisions in the Youth Command



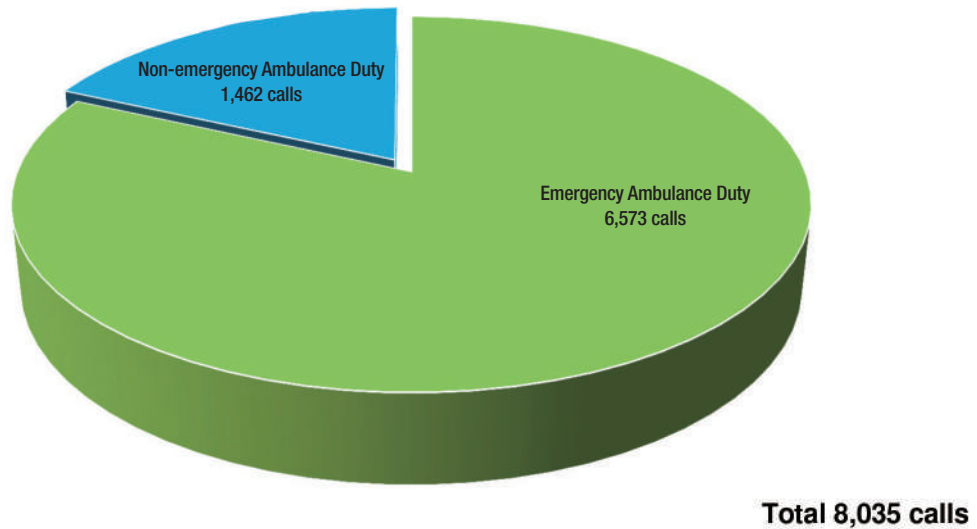
### Strength of the Brigade as at 31 March 2019
